For children who will be 4 years old by Sep. 1, 2024.

### Pre-K (4 Year Old) Program

**M/T/W/TH Class 1-3:30 p.m. \$219/month**

Afternoon PreK Program teaching Kindergarten readiness skills.

For children who will be 4 years old by Sep. 1, 2024.

### Pre-K (5 Year Old) Program

**M/T/W/TH Class 1-3:30 p.m. \$219/month**

PreK Program designed for children who are 5 years old and choose to wait a year to attend kindergarten. Based on enrollment numbers and openings, enrollments may be accepted for children who will turn 5 years old by Dec. 31, 2024 and missed the cut-off date to attend and are ready for additional challenges in their education.

+ A \$50 registration fee must be paid to reserve your child's place

+ A separate \$50 enrollment fee will apply for those children who also enroll in the extended-care program.

+ Rates are effective May 27, 2024 subject to increase at any time.

## Extended-Care Enrollment Information

### Infant/Younger Toddler Program

**Monday—Friday 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. \$229/week**

*For children ages 6 weeks up to 18 months of age and children 18 months of age to 24 months of age.*

### Older Toddler Program

**Monday—Friday 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. \$217/week**

*Children 2 years old by September 1st and will remain in this group until eligible for the 3 year old preschool class.*

### Preschool Program

**Monday—Friday 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. \$210/week**

*Children in this program must be eligible for one of the 3-5 year old Preschool classes. They will attend preschool class on the days they have signed up for at enrollment time. Children in 3 year old programs and up are required to be potty trained. Children enrolled in a morning class will be required to lay down at naptime.*

### Part-Time Preschool Age Extended-Care

**2 Days / Week \$99/week**

**3 Days / Week \$143/week**

*Part-time extended care will be available on the days your child attends Preschool (ages 3-5) ONLY. Availability will be based on current full-time students and part-time openings.*

### School Age After School Care

**Monday—Friday 2:45 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. \$80/week**

**Summer Full-Time (M-F) 7 a.m. —5:30 p.m. \$191/week**

**Summer Part-Time (T/W/TH) 7 a.m. —5:30 p.m. \$129/week**

*After school care is available for school age children kindergarten - 3rd grade. Transportation is provided from Discovery Elementary ONLY. Summer School-Age care is available the summer completing 3rd grade. Summer school-age children are required to have a Tea Area Pool Pass and Sioux Falls Library Card. All other activity fees are included with Summer School-Age tuition.*

*\* Prices include both preschool and extended-care.*

## Our Curriculum

We are committed to providing children with an educational, Christian-based program. The staff is dedicated to teaching children school-readiness and life skills through the daily schedule and activities we offer. The curriculum is based on educational and developmental theories and current research supporting the development of young children. We base our programs on the belief that children learn through play, interaction with others, modeled teaching approaches, and the opportunity to make individual choices.

Allowing children the opportunity to investigate, experiment, and explore concepts while interacting with others and participating in teacher-directed activities provides them with a sense of individuality, spirituality, and friendship while building on the development of the whole child. Children are provided a balanced amount of time to engage in structured and unstructured activities. Throughout the daily schedule they are able to participate in child and teacher-directed activities with daily lesson plans and the setup of the classroom environment.
